



Winterization Needs for the Displaced Populations In the Kurdistan Region-Iraq

Report No. (21)

Executive Summary:

As the publication of this report, more than one million IDPs and refugees remain in the Kurdistan Region, only 64,554 families (30%) are living in 39 camps (22 camps in Duhok, 11 camps in Erbil and 6 camps in Slemani) and the 70% are living with the host communities in formal and informal settlements in Erbil, Duhok and Slemani governorates. More than of the population are women, children and elderly and they need special care and attentions particularly during the winter season as the temperature degrees will dramatically go down. Most of the displaced people are not able to care for their family winter needs as they have no source of income and they are highly dependent on the assistance that they are provided.

Additionally, winter conditions are particularly difficult in the Kurdistan Region and a significant portion of the displaced families live in the shelters which lack adequate living conditions and essential items to protect them from the severe winter conditions. As there may be also flash floods, snowing and sever winds which the current shelters will not resist and these sever weather conditions will directly affect the camp residents.

The winterization needs are prepared in close cooperation with the camp administration and crisis response offices in the governorates and all the priority needs are identified for the displaced people in the camps and outside camps.

Moreover, the Kurdistan Region has witnessed new influx of refugees from Syrian due to the recent conflict in the north eastern Syria and since 14 October 2019, over 14,000 refugees arrived to Kurdistan and they are sheltered in Bardarash and Gawilan camps and they are also continuing to arrive daily and it is expected that the number will reach over 50,000 in the coming weeks. The new Syrian refugees arrived in Kurdistan Region are also in dire need of winter items and assistance. They also are in need of all forms of assistance, as they have brought nothing with them and over 51% are women and children.

We call upon the Federal Government of Iraq and the international community to mobilise resources and support the KRG in meeting these critical winterization needs of the vulnerable displaced people; IDPs and refugees. Failure to do so will result in the further suffering of thousands of vulnerable IDPs and refugees, particularly young children, the elderly, the sick and those with special needs.

Table (1) presents an overview of winterization needs of 258,314 displaced families in the three provinces of Erbil, Duhok and Slemani including tents/cabinets, heaters and gas canisters, kerosene, shoes, coats and winter clothing for different age groups and batter driven lamps. **Table (2)** presents a detailed breakdown per governorate and population group.
