

Winterization Needs for the Displaced Populations In the Kurdistan Region-Iraq

Report Number (11) 29 September 2020

Executive Summary:

The Kurdistan Region continues to host a large population of Syrian refugees and internally displaced Iraqis. Currently there are (218,257 families/990,707 individuals) of displaced people live in the Kurdistan Region which accounts for 98% of the total refugees and 65% of the total IDPs in Iraq. Now, (60,801 families) of IDPs and Refugees live in (37) camps (Erbil; 6 IDPs and 4 Refugee camps, Slemani; 5 IDPs and 1 refugee camps and Duhok; 16 IDPs and 5 refugee camps).



The winter season are especially difficult in the Kurdistan Region as the winter is very cold, with possible heavy snowfalls and frosts in December and January. Recently, the weather has become very static and the Kurdistan Region has had witnessed continued heavy raining and snow fall which resulted in flash flooding and freezing cold and heavy night frost and winds. The displaced people camps had been severely impacted due to the poor infrastructure of the camps and the shelters.



IDPs and Refugees family are not able to care for their families to meet winter needs as they have no source of income and they are highly dependent on the assistance that they are provided, especially with the COVID19 spread, those who used to have a kind of income, now they lost it and all of them need assistance.

As we approach the winter season, JCC has prepared this winterization priority needs to provide the displaced families with special winter needs and prepare the families and the camps for the winter to reduce the effects and mitigate the risks resulted in flash flooding, heavy snow falls and freezing cold.

The winterization plan has been led by JCC and prepared in close cooperation with the



camp administration and crisis response offices in the governorates and all the priority needs are identified for the displaced people and refugees in the camps. Winter conditions are particularly

difficult in the Kurdistan Region and a significant portion of the displaced families lack adequate living conditions and essential items to protect them from the severe winter conditions. Therefore, in this report the JCC has consolidated information regarding critical winterization needs for camp and non-camp refugee and IDP populations in the Region.

JCC calls on the federal government of Iraq and our humanitarian and donors in the international community to provide the required resources to meeting these critical winterization needs to mitigate the additional suffering and hardship for the IDPs and refugee families which they could not bear, particularly young children, the elderly, the sick and those with special needs.
